Dr. Mahama has been with USA School for International Training, Ghana Campus since 2003 as a lecturer, research advisor, and language coordinator. He holds a PhD in Sociolinguistics from the University of Reading in the United Kingdom and is currently a research fellow at the University of Development Studies (UDS) in Tamale.
